Sub:- Deputation of Shri R.K. PANDA (IRSSE, DOB:07/05/66, DITS:11/09/07), formerly Dy.CVO/East Coast Railway to Rail Vikas Nigam Ltd. (RVNL).


The sanction of the competent authority is hereby communicated to the deputation of Shri R.K. PANDA, IRSSE, East Coast Railway to RVNL as JGM (S&T) at Sambalpur on the following terms & conditions:-

- I.** Period: The effective tenure of the officer in RVNL will be from the date of relief i.e. 24.03.2022 (AN) till the date of his superannuation i.e. 31.05.2026 or until further orders, whichever is earlier, subject to exemption from the rule of immediate absorption.
- II.** Pay & Allowances: The officer will draw pay which would have been admissible to him from time to time on the Railways plus deputation (duty) allowance in terms of the Ministry of Personnel, PG & Pensions (Deptt. of Personnel & Training)'s OM No. 06/08/2009-Estt. (Pay-II) dated 17/06/2010 and No. 2/11/2017-Estt. (Pay-II) dated 24/11/2017 & 15.03.2021 circulated under Railway Board's letter No. 2010/F(E)II/I(I)/1 dated 28/07/2010 and F(E)II/2017/DE/1/2 dated 26/12/2017 & 17.01.2022 respectively.

Note:- Pay for this purpose does not include special pay, if any, drawn on the Railways.

2. The other terms and conditions will be as shown in the Annexure.
3. For the purpose of item IV (Travelling Allowance), item V (Medical Facilities), item VII (Leave & retirement benefits) and item VIII (Group Insurance Scheme) of the annexure, PFA, ECoR, Bhubaneswar will be the concerned officer.
4. This issues with the vetting of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.

TERMS APPLICABLE FOR DEPUTATION TO PUBLIC SECTOR
UNDERTAKING IN INDIA

- I DEARNESS ALLOWANCE: The officer shall be entitled to dearness allowance at the rate admissible to Government/Railway employees with reference to the pay in the cadre posts only.
- II HOUSE RENT ALLOWANCE: As admissible to officers of his status in the borrowing organisation.
- III JOINING TIME AND JOINING TIME PAY: The officer will be entitled to joining time when proceeding on and returning from deputation in accordance with the regulations of the borrowing organisation. The joining time pay both ways shall be payable by the borrowing organisation.
- IV TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE: The officer will be governed by the Railway Travelling Allowance Rules during joining time (both ways). The borrowing organisation will however arrange to credit to the Railway an amount equal to the transfer traveling allowance and incidental expenses admissible under their rules for the journey both ways (i.e. to take up the assignment and to return to Railways). The excess amount, if any, under the Railway rules will be borne by the borrowing organisation. Railway passes on transfer account for the officer and his family, and also for transporting his kit (a motor car if he possess one) will be issued to the officer by the railway from which he proceeds on deputation. For any journey undertaken during deputation in connection with the work of the borrowing organisation he will be governed by the rules of that organisation.
- V MEDICAL FACILITIES: The officer shall be eligible for medical facilities in accordance with the rules of the borrowing organisation applicable to the officers of corresponding status of that organisation. The borrowing organisation may, however, allow the officer at his option to enjoy railway medical facilities provided a contribution to the Railway revenues to be credited to the PA&CAO of the concerned Railway is made by the borrowing organisation or by the officer concerned, as may be mutually agreed upon between them, at the rates of recovery prescribed from time to time for officers of his status under CGHS.
- VI PRIVILEGE PASSES: The officer will be entitled to the benefits of passes and PTO's in terms of Board' letter No.E(W) 83 PS-5-15 dated 28.07.1984. He will, however, not be eligible to the benefits of "Leave Travel Concession" of borrowing organisation for their employees.

VII LEAVE AND RETIREMENT BENEFITS: The officer will continue to be governed by the leave and retirement benefit rules applicable to him as a Railway servant. The borrowing organisation will pay to the Railway Administration the usual contribution as laid down under Railway Rules, which will be intimated by the Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts Officer of the concerned Railway, who will make arrangements to effect recoveries regularly. The borrowing organisation will be liable to pay salary and allowance in respect of special disability leave, if any granted to the officer on account of any disability incurred in and through service under the borrowing organisation even, if such, disabilities manifests itself after termination of service with the organisation. In case of employees covered under the New Pension Scheme (NPS), the borrowing department shall make matching contribution to the NPS account of the employee.

VIII SUBSCRIPTION TOWARDS GROUP INSURANCE SCHEME: Unless the officer has opted out of the Group Insurance Scheme introduced with effect from 01.11.1982, the borrowing organisation will recover from him the usual subscription towards the Scheme under the Rules and permit the same to the TA&CAO concerned, who will intimate the rates of recovery and also make arrangement to effect contribution regularly.
