ORDER

The sanction of the President is hereby communicated to the deputation of Mr. VIJAY GARG, IRSE to NCRTC on the following terms & conditions:-

- I.** Period: Five years from the date of relief i.e.07.02.2022 (A/N) or until further orders whichever is earlier.
- II.** Pay & Allowances: The officer will draw pay which would have been admissible to him/her from time to time on the Railways plus deputation (duty) allowance in terms of the Ministry of Personnel , PG & Pensions (Deptt. of Personnel & Training)'s O.M No. 06/08/2009-Estt.(Pay-II)dated 17/06/2010 and No.2/11/2017-Estt.(Pay-II) dated 24/11/2017 and 15/03/2021circulated under Railway Board's letter No. 2010/F(E)II/I(I)/I dated 28/07/2010 and No.F(E)II/2017/DE/1/2 dated 26/12/2017 and 17/01/2022, respectively.

Note:- Pay for this purpose does not include special pay, if any, drawn on the Railways.

- 2 . The other terms and conditions will be as shown in the Annexure.
- 3 . For the purpose of item IV (Travelling Allowance), item V (Medical Facilities), item VII (Leave & retirement benefits) and item VIII (Group Insurance Scheme) of the annexure, Pr.FA, Northern Railway, New Delhi will be the concerned officer.
- 4 . This issue with the vetting of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.

TERMS APPLICABLE FOR LOAN OF SERVICE /FOREIGN SERVICE ETC IN INDIA

1. **DEARNESS ALLOWANCE:-** At Railway rates or rates of the borrowing organization according as the officer opts to draw pay in the Railway Scale or in the post of in the borrowing organization.
2. **HOUSE RENT & CITY COMPENSATORY ALLOWANCE:-** As admissible to officers of his status in the borrowing organization.
3. **JOINING TIME:-** The officer will be entitled to joining time when proceeding on and returning from deputation in accordance with the regulations of the borrowing organization. The joining time pay both ways shall be payable by the borrowing organization.
4. **TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE:-** Travelling allowance will be regulated by Board's Letter No. F(E)62 AL-28/11 dated 23.11.1963 in terms of which the governed by the Railway Travelling Allowance rules in to during joining time (both ways) only if the borrowing organization agrees to credit to the Railway Revenues the entire amount on account of the transfer Travelling Allowance and incidental expenses admissible under Railway Rules for the journeys both ways(i.e. to take up the assignment and to return to the Railways). Railway passes on transfer account for the officer and his family, and also for transport in his kit (and motor-car if any he possesses) will be issued to the officer by the Railway from which he proceeds on deputation in that case. For any journey undertaken during deputation in connection with the work of the borrowing organization, he will be governed by the rules of that organization.
5. **MEDICAL FACILITIES:-** "Railway employees on deputation in India, Railway employees sent on deputation to other Government Departments/Corporations/ Undertakings may be governed by the medical attendance rules of the borrowing Departments/Corporations/ Undertakings. The borrowing organization may, however, allow the Railway employees, at his/her option, to enjoy Railway Medical Facilities, provided a recovery prescribed from time to time for Government employees of his/her status under the Central Government Health Scheme(CGHS). However, in the case of borrowing Central and State Government departments, no such contribution is required to be paid and the employee will enjoy the Railway Medical Facilities free of cost as during Railway service."

6. **PRIVILEGE PASSES:-** The officer will be entitled to the benefits of passes and PTO's in terms of Board's letter No E(W) 83 PS 5-15 dated 28.07.1984. He will however, not be eligible to the benefits of "Leave Travel Concession" of borrowing organization for their employees.
7. **LEAVE AND RETIREMENT BENEFITS:-** The officer will be continue to be governed by leave and retirement benefit rules applicable to him as a Railway servant. The borrowing organization will pay to the Railway Administration the usual contribution as laid down under Railway Rules, which will be intimated by the Financial Advisor and Chief Accounts officer of the concerned Railway, who will make arrangements to effect recoveries regularly. The borrowing organization will be liable to pay salary and

allowance in respect of special disability leave, if any granted to the officer on account of any disability incurred in and through service under the borrowing organization even, if such, disabilities manifests itself after termination of service with the organization. In case of employees covered under the New Pension Scheme (NPS), the borrowing department shall make matching contribution to the NPS account of the employee.

- 8. SUBSCRIPTION TOWARDS GROUP INSURANCE SCHEME:-** Unless the officers has opted out of the GROUP INSURANCE SCHEME introduced with effect from 01.11.1982, the borrowing organization will recover from him the usual subscription towards the Scheme under the Rules and permit the same to the FA&CAO concerned who will intimate the rates of recovery and also make arrangement to effect contribution regularly.
